## 1.0 Background

The Black Dog Watershed Management Organization (BDWMO) commissioners are in the process of updating the BDWMO Watershed Management Plan (Plan). The BDWMO commissioners hosted a public hearing on the draft Plan during the August 17, 2022 BDWMO consistent with Minnesota Statutes 103B.231 Subd. 7c. Following the public hearing, the BDWMO engineer submitted that draft Plan to the Board of Water and Soil Resources (BWSR) and State review agencies for final (90-day review) on behalf of the BDWMO commissioners on August 22, 2022. This memorandum summarizes the remaining Plan review schedule.

## 2.0 Remaining Plan Review, Approval, and Adoption Schedule

The final Plan review by BWSR is termed a 90-day review although the process is typically completed on a shorter timeline. This timeline is summarized below:

**August 22, 2022** – BDWMO engineer submitted the revised draft Plan to BWSR for 90-day review. BWSR Board Conservationist Steve Christopher distributed the draft Plan to State review agency staff.

**September 23, 2022** – Comments from State review agencies are due to BWSR (during the 90-day review, all comments are compiled by BWSR).

**October 6, 2022** – BWSR Central Regional Subcommittee meeting. At this meeting, Board Conservationist Steve Christopher will present the highlights of the draft Plan to the BWSR Board and a recommendation from the Central Regional Subcommittee regarding Plan approval. Ideally, the BWSR Board will approve the draft Plan at this meeting.

**November 16, 2022** – The BDWMO commissioners adopt the *2023-2032 Black Dog Watershed Management Plan* (assuming BWSR approval at the October 26, 2022 BWSR Board meeting.



# 3.0 Next Steps

The BDWMO engineer will prepare a presentation on the draft Plan and coordinate with the BDWMO Administrator and/or commissioners to present at the October 6, 2022 BWSR Central Regional Subcommittee (pending the commissioners' decisions regarding attendance).
